The Town Board of the Town of Lyons met for a workshop on Wed. Feb. 6, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. in the Town Board meeting room.

This workshop was duly noticed by contacting the Times of Wayne newspaper, as well as posting a notice on the Town bulletin board and on the Town's web site.

All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

The purpose of the workshop was to review various items for the General Code project. There are a number of chapters within the proposed Town Code update that the Board must decide prior to sending the information to General Code Company for publishing the first draft. However, before that discussion, Supervisor Emmel wanted to finish making his Board Member liaison appointments now that Jim Brady has been appointed to the Board. Mr. Brady is the representative to Animal Control and will share a spot with Supervisor Emmel on the Shared Services Facility and share a spot with Councilwoman Greco on the Ambulance Department. In addition, Councilman Paliotti and Supervisor Emmel will serve on the Building and Grounds Committee.

Code Enforcement Officer Richard Bogan then ran down a listing of items the Board needs to make decisions on and/or give him direction on how to move forward with code considerations. Among them: Consumption of alcoholic beverages on Town property, animal control, SEQR process, authority to set speed limits and weight limits, parking time limits, and schedule of use and area regulations. The Board provided the necessary guidance to Mr. Bogan to keep the project moving forward. Some of the issues would need the guidance of the Town Attorney.

Supervisor Emmel then gave the Board a brief update regarding a meeting he had with County Officials regarding derelict properties in Lyons.

As there was no further business, the workshop was adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
