This workshop was duly noticed by contacting the Times of Wayne newspaper, as well as posting a notice on the Town bulletin board and on the Town's web site.

Supervisor Manktelow stated that he has been notified that a blower part at the sewer plant needs to be rebuild and replaced at a cost of \$26,840.00. Councilman Emmel moved to make the payment. Motion seconded by Councilman Paliotti. Vote:

Supervisor Manktelow then explained that the purpose of the workshop was to listen to a presentation from Charles Jordan from Professional Ambulance Billing (PAB) located in Buffalo, NY.

Keith Simon introduced Mr. Jordan from the agency and he discussed the proposal. He explained that his company serves about 60 ambulance departments and it bills solely for ambulances and not any other medical profession such as doctors' offices or hospitals. He said he has about 30 employees working for him. Mr. Jordan answered several questions from the Board.

After all questions had been answered, Supervisor Manktelow said the matter would be discussed further at the regular Board meeting on the 31st of this month.

As there was no further business, the workshop was adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
