The Town Board of the Town of Lyons met for a workshop on Wed. July 16, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Board meeting room.

This workshop was duly noticed by contacting the Times of Wayne newspaper, as well as posting a notice on the Town bulletin board and on the Town's web site.

Tonight's workshop was being conducted by Councilman Phil DeSain, due to a family medical emergency that has kept Supervisor Manktelow away from the office the entire day.

Councilman DeSain opened the workshop asking each Board member to update on what has been happening within his or her committee. Neither Councilmen D'Amato nor Councilman DeSain had anything new to report. Councilwoman Collins reported that it now appears that the Town and Village Court will be conducted at 76 William Street...upstairs...until dissolution becomes final in Jan. 2016. There is the possibility of moving it downstairs at 76 William Street after dissolution. Grant money may be available from the State Court Administration to update the facility. It's also probable that the move to 76 William Street for the Town court could happen sometime in the middle of September of this year.

Councilman DeSain opened the workshop up to the public with regard to questions or comments surrounding Village Dissolution. Village resident Mark Briggs spoke at great length with regard to the need to keep the Village Police Department in some form.

At 7:30 p.m., Councilman DeSain moved to go into executive session to discuss pending Highway Dept. contract negotiations. Motion seconded by Councilman D'Amato. Vote:
