The Town Board of the Town of Lyons met in its rooms on Thursday Nov. 6, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. to conduct a Public Hearing on the proposed 2015 Town budget as well as discuss any other business that comes before the Board.

This Public Hearing was duly noticed by contacting the Times of Wayne newspaper as well as posting a notice on the Town Bulletin Board.

All stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Supervisor Manktelow opened the Public Hearing on the proposed budget package as well as to whether the Town should enter into a fire protection contract with the Village of Lyons at a cost of \$ 172,601.87

The Hearing would remain open until all comments had been heard. The proposal calls for a tax decrease of about 2 cents per thousand for residents inside the Village, and a 6 cents per thousand decrease for residents living outside the Village. In addition, the fire protection amount would increase 39 cents per thousand ( about 22 percent) for those residents outside the Village.

After all comments had been heard, Councilman DeSain moved to close the Public Hearing. Motion seconded by Councilman LaGasse. Vote:

In other business, Councilman LaGasse moved to reappoint Mr. Anthony Tiballi to another 5 year term on the Assessment Board of Review. Motion seconded by Councilman DeSain. Vote:

Councilman DeSain voting aye  
Councilman LaGasse voting aye  
Supervisor Manktelow voting aye

The term will expire in Sept. 2019.

As there was no further business, the Public hearing was adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
