This meeting was duly noticed by contacting the Times of Wayne newspaper, as well as posting a notice on the Town bulletin board and on the Town's web site.

All stood for Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisor Manktelow then asked for a moment of silence to honor fallen Rochester Police Officer Daryl Pierson, whose funeral was held today.

Supervisor Manktelow opened the workshop by introducing Wayne County Sherriff Barry Virts. Sherriff Virts was asked to speak to the Board and answer questions with regard to police protections once the Village of Lyons is dissolved. Sherriff Virts said he wasn't attending the workshop to propose any ideas but rather to answer questions. He touched upon topics such as road patrol, code enforcement, response time, police coverage, and record retention.

Sgt. Brendlinger from the Lyons Police Dept. explained how the local police could or could not deal with coverage of the entire town if the force became a Town-wide force.

In an unrelated matter, Councilman LaGasse suggested that a banner be purchased to hang over the former water plant on Clyde Rd., indicating where the Town Recycling location is, and also a couple of magnetic signs alerting residents as to what types of electronic equipment is accepted at the now opened electronics recycling site, also on Clyde Road. As the Mayor was in attendance, he said he would take the idea back to the Village Board for review, but he personally didn't see a problem with both suggestions.

At 8:15 p.m., Councilman DeSain moved to go into executive session to discuss an employment matter. Motion seconded by Councilman D'Amato. Vote:
